Module 1: The Big Easy? New Orleans, Louisiana

The New Orleans module brings students to one of the United States' oldest and most unique cities. An urban laboratory steeped in history, New Orleans illuminates the diversity to be found within the United States. Students will explore its rich history, current challenges, and future outlook with local experts, and learn about the political significance of the Deep South in the light of the upcoming Presidential elections.

Module 2: Politics of Power Washington DC

The Washington DC module brings students to the nation's capital and political epicenter at a most critical time. Hosted by the Austrian Embassy in the United States, we will look at the current political dynamics and analyse them with analysed by experts from local universities and think tanks.
