Cultural Property

... movable or immovable property of great importance to the cultural heritage of all people, such as monuments of architecture, art or history, whether religious or secular; archaeological sites, ... works of art; manuscripts, books and other objects of artistic, historical or archaeological interest; ... buildings whose main and effective purpose is to preserve or exhibit the moveable cultural property ...

(Hague Convention 1954, Art. 1, paras. a, b)





Registration - why?

It is an important professional responsibility to ensure that all items accepted temporarily or permanently by the museum are properly and fully documented to facilitate provenance, identification, condition and treatment.

(ICOM Code of Professional Ethics, 1990)

- Who brought it? (person, address, signature)
- Papers concerning possession (contract...)
- Short description
- Date of arrival
- Name of the employee who received it



- Inventory personnel has to be at the spot during evacuation




